Albert Donald Currie, age 94, passed away Saturday afternoon, April 3, 2010 in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan. Albert was born in Huron Town, Michigan on March 24, 1916 to Benjamin and Ruth (Rayten) Currie. He was raised and worked on Sugar Island until he went into the service. He was a proud veteran of World War II, who served overseas in North Africa and Italy. Albert retired after 30 years of service from the U.S. Corps of Engineers. He served as crane operator, truck driver, and parks and grounds. After retirement, he enjoyed "gentleman farming", raising Percheron Horses, and helping neighbors.
