Angela Ann Litzner, 57, of St. Ignace went to be with Jesus on Saturday, October 26, 2019 from the University Hospital in Ann Arbor after a short fight with cancer. Angela was born on January 29, 1962 to Alice (Moore) Howe and the late Jerome Lee. She married David Litzner on November 24, 1979 at Glenn Memorial Baptist Church. Angela's life was devoted to her family and invested in people. Her smile would light up the room and the warmth of her heart would fill your soul. Angie's life was one of simplicity that valued the little things we often overlook but greatly appreciate. You couldn't help but be drawn to her compassionate, caring personality or be encouraged by her genuine love demonstrated in serving others. Her generosity involved more than a bullet point list of community service activities and her impact was felt in this community by the many ways in which she gave of herself in loving, personal expressions. Each person impacted by Angela felt as if they were the most important person in the room, that they had a special connection with her that no one else had, and that they were loved without condition and accepted without requirement. Her listening ear combined with her gentle spirit made you feel valued and cared for in a deeply personal way. We have been richly blessed by her life.
