Angelic "Angie" Marie (Mayer) Krol, age 62, died on July 24, 2024, in Pickford, Michigan, surrounded by her loving family after a short battle with bile duct cancer. She was born on July 17, 1962 in Fibre, Michigan, to Eugene and Lois (Grant) Mayer.

Angie grew up in Fibre and attended Rudyard High School where she graduated with the Class of '80. After high school, she attended Lake Superior State College, where she met her adoring husband of forty-one years, Robert "Bob" Krol, and they both graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree.
