Anne C Stadler, 77, of Drummond Island, Michigan, died on January 20, 2016, at her home, surrounded by her family.

Anne was born September 9, 1938 in Cleveland, Ohio to Carl Frederick Guenther and Marie Davis Guenther. She grew up and attended school in Cleveland and after graduation, moved to Milwaukee, Wisconsin to attend Marquette University. She married and raised her children in Milwaukee. In 1985, she moved to Drummond Island, Michigan and took up residence on a long time family property.

Anne had a helping spirit, as was evidenced by her countless hours of community service. Anne served as chairman of the Drummond Island Clinic Board, which was the focus of her volunteerism. She also taught a 4-H Photo class for 6 years. Anne was a member of St. Florence Catholic Church, which was built by her grandparents, J.C. and Ada Davis, in memory of their daughter Florence. Through the years Anne served as President of the Parish Council, and member of the Finance Committee, a member of St. Florence Guild, religious education teacher and lector. Anne served on the board of the Drummond Island Historical Society, and the Food Bank Committee. She was a charter member of the Drummond Island Sportsman Club and the Diggers Garden Club. Anne was a member of the Drummond Island Homemakers and a substitute teacher. Anne was also a member of the Drummond Island

Ambulance Corps, as an EMT-S.

Anne was an avid photographer who took many pictures professionally and personally. She also liked to garden, cook, and read.

As a business owner, she started the monthly newspaper, the Drummond Island Digest, and owned Portraits by Annie and Annie's Attic Bed and Breakfast & Gift Shop.

Anne is survived by her children, Jeanmarie (Bob) Vlasak of Pewaukee, Wisconsin, Pam (Bill) Perego of Sussex, Wisconsin, Dan (Roberta) Stadler of Menomonee Falls, Wisconsin; and daughter-in-law, Laura Stadler. Anne is also survived by grandchildren, Jake and Karlie Stadler, Billy and Andy Perego, Nick Stadler; great granddaughter, Alma Jean Stadler; sister, Florence Connole of Fairview Park, Ohio; nephew, Jon (Kelly) Connole; niece, Suzy (Jim) Sayre; great nephews and nieces, Sean, Ryan and Kyle Connole, Alex and Kateri Sayre. Anne also leaves behind her beloved cats Bob and Baby.
