



## Annette "Annie" Klara Peterson

Annette "Annie" Klara (Beaulieu) Peterson, age 88, of Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan, died on February 22, 2024, at Medilodge in Sault St. Marie. She was born on December 8, 1935, in Sault Ste. Marie to Armand and Ila (Luoma) Beaulieu.

Annie grew up in Sault Ste. Marie and graduated from Sault Area High School.
