Burton J. Rutledge, 72 of Moran died Tuesday, March 20 at Evergreen Living Center following a lingering illness. He was born in Saginaw on August 12, 1939 to Jack and Gladys (Lee) Rutledge. He graduated from LaSalle High School in 1958 and from Big Bay DeNoc in 1960. He was the assistant Manager of the Do It Center for 35 years. He served on the Brevort Township Fire Dept. for 51 years, and was Assistant Fire Chief at the time of his death. He served on the Brevort Township Board for 35 years as Supervisor, Secretary and Trustee. He also served on the Board of Review and Planning Commission.
