Audie M. Potter, age 67, a resident of Manitowoc, Wisconsin, and formerly of Pickford, Michigan, entered eternal life on Tuesday, December 12, 2023, at his residence. He was born on September 13, 1956, in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan, to Marvin and Kathleen (Batho) Potter.

Audie graduated from Pickford High School with the class of 1974.
