Her parents were farmers, and she was the only girl in a family of 4 boys..Her parents were William & Anetta (Roll) Huffman. Being around boys all the time she became a sports fanatic. She loved basketball, and played high school ball and for Ball State College in Muncie, Indiana, in fact one game she scored 50 points herself, winning the game nearly single handed. She graduated with a teachers degree, and taught 4th, 5th & 6th graders. She taught herself to drive, as there were no drivers training programs. Her Mom did not like to drive, so she drove her everywhere. Her chores on the farm when she was little was "picking eggs". She called it "picking" rather than gathering. She loved her childhood, especially first snow. She loved bowling, in fact she did not quit until she was in her 90's, and her last game was 235. She was also an avid golfer. She married her basketball coach, David Craig in 1931 and he died in 1975. They lived in Ligoneer, Indiana and Lake Wawasee, Indiana many years. They were regular visitors at Brevort Lake, and owned property there since in the 50's. They were regular visitors at Slim & Mayme Eubanks', and were from the same area of Indiana. She moved to Hesperia, MI in 1997. She has been in assisted living 30 months in Cedarville.
