Joseph \"Snapper\" Bazinaw, 78 of Mackinac Island died early Monday morning, March 5 at Mackinac Straits Hospital following a lingering illness. He was born on the Island on May 6, 1934 to Alexander and Catherine (Chapman) Bazinaw, one of eleven children. He lived on Mackinac all his life except for a time in the US Marine Corp. during the Korean War. He worked for the Mackinac Island State Parks until his retirement as a Teamster many years.
