Charles "Chuck" Eugene Haas, 90, of Delton, Michigan passed away December 7, 2023 in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan. He was born to Charles and Annabelle (Meiser) Haas in Bristol, Indiana on November 9, 1933.

Chuck moved to Battle Creek, Michigan at an early age where he graduated from Battle Creek Central High School in 1952. He proudly served our country in the U.S. Army from 1953 to 1956.
