



## Charles "Chuck" M. Harrison

December 6, 1952 - January 14, 2024

Charles "Chuck" MacGowan Harrison, age 71, of Moran, Michigan, died at his home on January 14, 2024. He was born on December 6, 1952, in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan, to MacGowan and Margaret (Rye) Harrison.

Chuck grew up in Pickford, Michigan, and graduated from Pickford High School in 1971.
