Timmy Bruce Huskey, 56 of Evergreen Shores, St. Ignace passed away unexpectedly Thursday, Sept. 6 at his home of an apparent heart attack. He was born December 19, 1955 in St. Ignace to Arthur and Jean (Roy) Huskey. The Huskey twins were the first twins born at the new Mackinac Straits Hospital. He graduated from LaSalle High School in 1974, an accomplished athlete, especially in football. and Timmy and Tommy were a great threat to every team they played. He had a superb work ethic, learning from his parents as did all his family. His father owned Art Huskey and Sons Excavating for many years. Tim did many major construction projects in St. Ignace area, and was well known as a finish carpenter and cabinet maker. He loved hunting and fishing, and had a turtle farm at his home, second to none. He had a great imagination for construction, and many in the community have projects he has completed. In his youth he had a horse named Little Bit, which took all the prizes at the Mackinac Co. Fair with Tim as rider bareback.

Tim is survived by his mother, Jean Huskey, St. Ignace; brothers, Wade and Kit, all of St. Ignace; a sister, Pamela and Tom Sutton, Kinross; nieces and nephews, Casey, Rachel, Krista, and Tyler and a great nephew, Chance. He was preceded in death by his father, Arthur Huskey in 1985; a brother, Chipper in 2004, and his twin brother, Tommy in May of 2009. Also a baby brother, Roger in 1950.

Mass of Christian burial will be Tuesday, Sept, 11 at 2 pm at ST. Ignatius Church with Fr. Pawel Mecwell and Fr. Norbert Landreville officiating. The family will receive friends and family at the church from 12 noon until service time. Burial will be in Brevort Township Cemetery, Allenville beside his twin brother, Tommy.
