



## Tom Vincent Wilder

Tom Vincent Wilder, 99 of Mackinac island died Saturday, March 19,2011 at his home at Surrey Hills.

He was born Fenruary 16,1912 in Ohio to Reverend Alfred J. and Lilla (nee Sheppard) Wilder.

His father was an Episcopal clergyman on Mackinac Island and several other places, including the Washington Cathedral, from 1928 to 1931, and rector at St.Andrews Episcopal Church in the District of Columbia from 1931 to 1939.

Mr. Wilder attended West Point for one year, where he played football and was injured. He earned a degree in forestry at Georgetown, and then a master\'s degree at the University of Michigan. He worked for the Department of the Interior in Washington,D.C from 1939 to 1969, and wrote many speeches for senators. This was a division of Library of Congress. He was confirmed on Mackinac Island by Rt. Rev. Herman Page July 12,1925.

He is survived by a sister, Lilla Patricia Dungan. He was preceeded in death by his parents and a brother in law, William Ashton Dungan of St.Michaels, Maryland.

Burial will be on Mackinac Island next to his father on Tuesday, June 7,2011. Dodson Funeral Home ,St.Ignace assisted with arrangements.
