On a nice day, it was rare for those who drove by not to see Marie enjoying one of her favorite pastimes: sitting on her porch watching all of the traffic. It didn't take a lot to make her happy. She always enjoyed visits to the casino, "quick" trips to Wal-Mart, watching her sons and grandsons play softball, or attending any events her grandkids were involved in at the schools.

The times Marie spent with her family were her happiest. She loved Christmas time and the Fourth of July, but anytime someone came to the door she always greeted them with a smile - and never said good bye.
