



## Claudina Johnson

July 10, 1917 - July 13, 2011

CLAUDINA REINHARD JOHNSON, formerly of Brimley and Sault Ste. Marie, passed away on July 13 in The Villages, Florida after a very brief illness. She was born to the late Andrew William and Mary Bridget (Kelly) Reinhard in Brimley Michigan on July 10, 1917. After attending grade school in Brimley, she graduated from Loretto Academy in the Soo in 1935. On June 24, 1942, Claudina married Oscar E. Johnson, who predeceased her in 1996. After Oscar's service in the U.S. Navy during World War II, the couple lived in the Soo from 1945 to 1954 where he taught in the junior high school. In 1954 the family moved to Lincoln Park, Michigan, when Oscar accepted a position as a principal in the Southgate school system. Claudina lived in Lincoln Park until 2005, Waterford, Michigan, until 2008, and Marietta, Georgia, until moving to The Villages in November 2010. She enjoyed travel, reading, following the Tigers and Pistons, and working in various Catholic organizations. Claudina is survived by a daughter, Colleen Johnson of The Villages, Florida, and Reinhard (Claire) Johnson of Brimley. She is also survived by two step-grandchildren, Miguel Montoya of Brimley and Catherine Montoya of Quezon City, the Philippines. Claudina was a wonderful mother and a kind person. She will be missed. The family will receive callers at St. Mary's Pro-Cathedral from 9:30-11:00 a.m. on Thursday, July 21, before Fr.
