Cynthia Jane Gough, age 67, Cedarville, Michigan, died on March 9, 2017 at Hospice of the E.U.P in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan. She was born on May 13, 1949 in Petoskey, Michigan to James Patrick and Wilma Susan (Kompsi) Francis.

Cindy grew up in Mackinac Island, Michigan and graduated from St. Ignace High School. She began working on the Island for William Gough at the riding stables.
