September 29, 1951 - March 8, 2012

Cynthia Marie Wilcox, age 60, originally from Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan passed away on Thursday, March 8, 2012 at the University of Michigan Hospital in Ann Arbor, after spending the past year and a half recovering from a liver transplant. Cynthia is the daughter of Art (deceased) and Norajean Wilcox of the Sault.
