



Dale E. Bishop

October 29, 1928 - January 22, 2018

Dale E. Bishop, age 89, of Dafter, Michigan was called home to his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ on Monday, January 22, 2018.

Dale was born in Lambs, Michigan on October 29, 1928, the son of the late Adrian and Mildred (Hall) Bishop. On November 4, 1950, he married Mary Rose Steele in the Free Methodist Church of Memphis, Michigan. Dale served his country in the United States Coast Guard immediately following World War II. He earned an Associate's Degree from Madonna University. Later, he worked as a fire safety manager for Chrysler Corporation retiring in 1991.

Dale is survived by ten of his thirteen children: Don (Shannon) Bishop of Sault Ste. Marie, MI, Allen Bishop of Dafter, MI, Clare (Janice) Bishop of Goodells, MI, Martha (Otis) Blankenship of Kentucky, Dwight (Diane) Bishop of Brimley, MI, Bruce (Paula) Bishop of Richmond, MI, Louis (Amy) Bishop of Port Huron, MI, Leona (Tim) Moses of Mt. Dale was preceded in death by his parents; his wife of 65 years: Mary Rose Bishop; and three children: Kenneth, Naomi, and Russell Bishop.

Dale put his faith and trust in Jesus Christ. He believed the words of John 3:16, For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. Dale is in heaven. Will you be there someday with him?
