



Dale Edward Lasecki

March 5, 1960 - January 28, 2016

Dale E. Lasecki, 55, Sault Ste. Marie, died unexpectedly from health complications on Jan. 28, 2016 at his home. He was born March 5, 1960 in Green Bay, Wisc. to Leonard and Regina Lasecki, and grew up on the family farm in Pulaski, Wisc. Dale joined the Marines right out of high school, serving with the 3rd Battalion, 8th Marines, out of Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. Following his service, he attended Northern Michigan University, where he played football and graduated with a degree in criminal justice and a minor in sociology. He was a licensed builder and worked for 23 years with the Michigan Dept. of Corrections from 1987-2010, earning the department's Valor Award for his service during a potential escape attempt while he was working with the Kinross Transportation Unit. A sports enthusiast, Dale spent many hours watching his sons play sports through the years and also enjoyed working with the Christopher Columbus Italian-American Society, where he was a member of the board of directors. He took great pride in projects at the CC Hall, including the handicap-accessible ramp that he helped build on the south side of the hall. He also enjoyed spending time at the Pingatore family cabin on Lake Superior. Dale is survived by his wife, Ann, and his sons Garrett and Aaron. He was preceded in death by his parents, Leonard and Regina Lasecki, who lived in Krakow, Wisc. Survivors also include his seven brothers, Leonard, Kenneth (Judy), Dennis (Pamela), Rodney, Chad (Maria), Brad (Elise), and Troy (Carolee); three sisters, Karen (Gregory) Simons, Rhoda (Bob) Beran, and Charlene (Michael) VanDenElzen; as well as aunts,

uncles, nieces and nephews. A memorial mass will be held at noon on Monday, Feb. 1, at St. Joseph's Church, with Father Michael Chenier as celebrant. Memorial donations may be made to St. Mary's School in Sault Ste. Marie and Dogs in Honor, P.O. Box 7363, Traverse City, 49696, which pairs veterans suffering from post-traumatic stress disorder with service dogs.
