Dale Andrew Murphy, age 67, of Brimley, Michigan passed away Sunday morning, January 3, 2016 at War Memorial Hospital. Dale was born on August 30, 1948 in Bradford, Pennsylvania to the late Dawson and Jessie (Wilcox) Murphy. He graduated from Clearwater High School in Clearwater, Florida. On March 25, 1968, Dale married Kathleen "Edna" Parish in Denver, Colorado. Dale joined the United States Air Force during the Vietnam War and was given the task of civil engineer/construction worker while in Vietnam. After many more years of service, he was discharged from Wheeler Air Force Base in Hawaii.
