Daniel Kobes, age 33, of Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan passed away Thursday afternoon, November 19, 2009 at the University of Michigan Hospital in Ann Arbor, Michigan. Dan was born on September 16, 1976 in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan, the son of Kenneth and Debra (Lawrence) Kobes. He graduated from Sault High School with the class of 1995. He attended Kalamazoo Community College and Lake Superior State University. He worked for Soo Supervalu since 2003. While in college, he enjoyed being a radio D.J. For WLSO. He also enjoyed spending time on the computer and watching the Detroit Tigers. Dan collected just about anything, from books, movies, and cd's to Star Wars Trading Cards. He was a member of the Sault Wesleyan Church where he was on the local board of administration. He also taught Sunday School, led a small group, and was very active with Guatemala Missions.
