February 9, 1920 - June 20, 2008

James Daniel Rose, age 88, of Dafter, Michigan passed away on Friday, June 20, 2008 at his home. He was born in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan on February 9, 1920. He served his country in the U.S. Army during World War II as a drill instructor in Little Rock, Arkansas. On August 22, 1946, he married his wife, Germainne, at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Sault Ste. Marie. Dan worked for Dafter Moving and Construction Company, moving many houses in and around the EUP.
