Deon Berlin, aka "Squeeky", age 79, of Dafter, Michigan died Tuesday, August 19, 2008 at War Memorial Hospital in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan. He was born May 5, 1929 in Fort Wayne, Indiana to Obed Floyd and Opal Marie (Kuehn) Berlin. Deon grew up in Fort Wayne. After high school, he served in the United States Air Force for 22 years. While stationed at Kincheloe Air Force Base in Michigan, he met Fern Lucille Smith and they were married on November 26, 1955 in Sault Ste. Marie. They owned Berlin's Resort in Cedarville for many years. Deon was a "jack of all trades" who did work as a licensed electrician, electrical inspector, refrigeration repair, plumbing and carpentry. Deon was a long time member of the Law-White VFW Post #7958 in Hessel and was active in the Coast Guard Auxiliary. For the last few years, he has enjoyed the races at the Kinross Speedpark where he was an active volunteer and operator of the "Clown Car." Deon is survived by his wife, Fern; three daughters, Karen Carrington of Dafter, Linda and her husband Don Prisk of Sault Ste. Marie, and Tricilla Berlin of Brimley, Michigan; one son Ernest and his wife Tess Berlin of Virginia Beach, Virginia; five grandchildren, Adam Uhrig, Sean Uhrig, Nicholas Carrington, Michael Berlin and Victoria Berlin; and one great grandchild, Scarlett Uhrig. Also surviving are three sisters, Phyllis Francis of Fort Wayne, Sonja Fryer of Henderson, North Carolina, and Reva Allen of Fort Wayne.
