Diana Carol Woods, age 55, of Goetzville, Michigan, died on July 5, 2019 at her home. She was born on March 26, 1964 in Elwood City, Pennsylvania to John Jeffery and Katharine Margaret (McCready) Casuccio.

Diana grew up in Elwood City and graduated from Beaver County Christian School. She attended Geneva College and the University of Alaska in Kodiak, Alaska. She met Aaron William Woods in 1992 and they married on August 28, 1993 in Darlington Pennsylvania. She worked several years as a sales representative for Star Stainless Screw Company and as an aid at McGuire Memorial Homes. While raising two children, Diana and Aaron moved around with the United States Coast Guard to Ketchikan, Alaska, Kodiak, Alaska, Eureka, California, Crescent City, California, Miami, Florida, Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan, back to Kodiak then settling in Goetzville. Diana worked as a manager at a dental office in Kodiak for a year and was a supervisor for the U.S Coast Guard Exchange for two years.

Diana was a member of the First Baptist Church in Alaska and Community Baptist in Florida. She was a volunteer with Kodiak Hospice, she was very involved with the Crisis Pregnancy Center as well as Home Schooling Community Leader. She was a volunteer for Kodiak Area Mentor Program (KAMP).

Diana was an avid Pittsburg Steelers Fan, but if they were not playing she was always rooting for the underdog. She liked cooking, reading, gardening, being outdoors – fishing, hunting, hiking, riding ATV. She loved to spend time with her children and playing volleyball. Diana had a very infectious personality and was very kindhearted. She opened her home to many people that needed help to get back on their feet.
