Ronald R. Almas, 74 of Pte Aux Chenes passed away peacefully Tuesday, July 31 at his home. He was born November 28, 1937 in Detroit. He graduated from high school and spent 2 years in the US Army during the Korean War, serving overseas 1 year. His rank was E-3. He was a supply clerk and a stock clerk.
