Timothy Morris Brooks passed away early Monday, December 22nd, peacefully, at home, surrounded by family. He was taken from us by cancer.

Tim was born on May 10th, 1943, in Amarillo, Texas, to Irene and Morris Brooks. In 1962, while serving in the United States Army, Tim married the love of his life - Linda. Tim and Linda lived in St. Johns, Michigan, while he worked at Motor Wheel in Lansing until the plant closed, then he and Linda moved back to Linda's original home town of Ozark, Michigan, where they lived until his passing.

Tim loved the outdoors; hunting, fishing, trapping, snowmobiling, quad riding, and just about anything else that had to do with getting out in nature. Family was very important to him, and he spent his life constantly involved in family activities.
