Michael G. Lasley Jr. 79 of St..Ignace died early Friday morning, December 17 at Hospice House in Cheboygan following a short illness. He was born In St..Ignace on April 17 1931. His parents were Michael G. Lasley Sr. and Ida McCrory Lasley.

He graduated from LaSalle High School in 1949 and entered the United States Army during the Korean War. He served 2 years, and departed as a Tech. Sgt. at the Artillery Center, Fort Sill, Oklahoma. He married Nell Edwards on October 11, 1957 in Angola, Indiana., and she died March 27, 2000. He owned Lasley Builders many years, and worked on the construction of the Mackinac Bridge after he came home from service.. He lived in Pontiac from 1957 to 1972, and worked for Bundy Construction. Moving back to St.Ignace, he and Nell owned the Nicholet Lounge for 10 years, and he continued Lasley Construction. He is a member of the American Legion Post; Moose Lodge, and an Elder with the Sault Tribe Chippewa Indians. He also did commercial fishing with his father and Jay Gillespie .. He loved the Kewadin Casino, and had strict limits because he only wanted to donate his share to the Tribe.He was also a longtime member of St.Ignatius Loyola Catholic Church.

He is survived by his children; Terry Edwards, Pontiac; Michael Lasley III, Panama City, Florida; Mary Ann and George Heath, Iron River; Sue and John St.Louis, St.Ignace; brothers, Larry and Sharron Lasley, St..Ignace; Jim and

Diane Lasley, Harbor Springs; 7 grandchildren and 2 great grandchildren; many nieces and nephews and companion & fiance, Darlene Bellville.. He was preceded in death by his sister, Clara Oja in 1983. and a daughter in law Mary Beth Edwards, and his wife.

A graveside service will be held in April at Gros Cap Cemetery, and he will be buried beside his wife.
