Dorothy Alleta Paquin, age 83, of Cedarville, Michigan, died unexpectedly at her home September 21, 2018. Dorothy was born on March 26, 1935 to Clarence Nelson and Bessie Amelia Matson (Campbell) in Flint, Michigan.

Dorothy grew up in Flint and California traveling for her father's electrician work.
