Dorothy Alice Scott, age 98, of Brimley, Michigan passed away Saturday morning, December 17, 2016 at War Memorial Hospital's Long Term Care Unit. Dorothy was born on June 2, 1918 in Pellston, Michigan, the daughter of the late Ray and Addie (Harris) Zimmerman. She graduated from Pellston High School and later earned her Associate's Degree from Eastern Michigan University. On May 27, 1937, she married Harold Russell Scott.
