



Edward Stanley Biernat

November 4, 1924 - February 19, 2014

Edward "Wire Ed" Stanley Biernat, age 89, of Kincheloe, Michigan passed away early Wednesday morning, February 19, 2014 at the Hospice of the EUP - Hospice House. Ed was born in Detroit, Michigan on November 4, 1924, the son of the late Stanley and Katherine (Pachut) Biernat. He was a 1942 graduate of Chadsey High School in Detroit. Ed was a Second Lieutenant fighter pilot during World War II, serving his country in the United States Army Air Corps. Later he was in the Army Air Corps Reserve. On October 23, 1954, he married Mary Helen Jozwiak in Detroit, Michigan. He was employed as an iron worker and was a member of the Shopmen's Local #508. In December 1991, he moved to Kincheloe, MI. He was an avid fisherman and was proud to have been in the July 2000 issue of Michigan Out of Doors Magazine. Ed is survived by his wife: Mary Helen Biernat of Kincheloe, MI; a daughter: Nancy (Shawn) Aston of Kincheloe, MI; and two grandsons: Matthew Aston of Pittsburgh, PA and Kevin Aston of Cadillac, MI. He is also survived by a brother: Walter Biernat of Pinckney, MI; and four sisters: Kathleen (Marshall) Fiveash of Livonia, MI, Albena (John) Selow of New Hudson, MI, Lillian (Dean) Reynolds of Livonia, MI, and Edwardeen (Jerry) Laskey of Pinckney, MI. He was preceded in death by his parents and three sisters: Frances Duchovic, Emily Austin, and Jennie Theisen. A memorial service will be held at 3:00 PM on Saturday, February 22, 2014 at C.S.
