Florence Lovegrove, 80 of St. Ignace passed away early Saturday morning, April 30 at home following a lingering illness. She was born in Cross Village on November 10, 1935. Her parents were George and Anna (Duvernay) Warren. She attended the Holy Cross School in Harbor Springs. She retired from Mackinac Straits Hospital in Housekeeping after 37 years of faithful service. She was one of 12 children born to the Warren household.
