Bertha Glashaw, 90 of St. Ignace passed away Tuesday evening, January 13 on her way to Petoskey Hospital by ambulance. She had been in the Hospital in St. Ignace several days since New Years day. On February 5, 1945 she married Frank L. Glashaw Jr., and he died August 1, 1991.
