Francis "Frank" Lee Wood, age 84, of Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan passed away early Thursday morning, February 22, 2018, at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital in New Brunswick, NJ.

Francis was born June 17, 1933, in Silverwood, Michigan to the late Ross and Neva (Brink) Wood. He was a graduate of Mayville High School, in Mayville, Michigan, class of 1952. He married Sharon Kay Schultz of Imlay City, MI on July 25, 1970.

His passion was farming and John Deere tractors. After marrying Sharon in 1970, they continued to farm the Wood Family farm in Silverwood, MI.

Francis and Sharon moved to Au Gres, MI in 1974 and purchased their own dairy farm (FranShar farm) until moving to Tawas City in 1982. He continued farming each summer with his nephew, Stan (Karen) Howard up until his death. Francis was an active member of Hemlock Road Baptist Church for over 30 years until he moved to Sault Ste. Marie, MI.

Francis moved to Sault Ste. Marie in April 2016 and volunteered his time at Lake Superior State University helping the Campus Life and Housing Office and especially the mascot, Seamore the SeaDuck. He fell in love with Sault Ste. Marie and LSSU and was a true Laker being known as 'Dad' across campus.

Francis is survived by his daughters Sharmay Wood of Sault Ste. Marie, MI, and Sharla Wood of East Brunswick, NJ. He is also survived by his sister:
