Frederick Donald "Freddie" Albon, age 72, of Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan passed away Friday, July 6, 2018, at War Memorial Hospital.

Freddie was born on October 21, 1945, in Sault Ste., Marie, Michigan to the late Earl and Violet (Massey) Albon. Freddie graduated from Sault High School, class of 1966.
