Floyd E. 'Eddie' Brown, 54 of Moran Township died unexpectedly early Wednesday morning, June 1 at his home, the day after his 54th birthday. He was born May 31, 1957 in Hinsdale, Ill. to Floyd and Helen (Taylor) Brown .He graduated from high school and completed schooling as a chef, and was a marine chef for 11 years on the Great Lakes, mainly for the Gatex Steamship Line, and others. He has spent 13 years in Florida, and owned a Deli at one time. He also lived in Chicago area many years. He loved his Toledo friends also. Most recently he worked for Star Line in St. Ignace. He was in a serious auto accident in 1998, and spent over a year and a half in recovery, and walked again contrary to Doctors prognosis. His friends say he had a great sense of humor, and could have been a stand up comedian.

He is survived by his mother, Helen Brown, Port St. Lucie, Florida and St. Ignace; 2 sisters, Diane Talley, Daytona Beach, Florida; Marsha & Pete Starling, Jacksonville, Florida; cousins, aunts and uncles, and many friends. He was preceded in death by his father, Floyd 'Paddy' Brown in 1986 and a brother Charles in April, 2010.

Cremation has taken place and a private burial of his ashes will be in St. Ignatius Cemetery next to his father and brother.
