January 13, 1945 - November 19, 2015

George Kent Logan, 70, of Kinross, passed away at his residence after a courageous battle with cancer on November 19, 2015. George was born in Claremore, Oklahoma to Amos and Alice (Moore) Logan on January 13, 1945 and was big brother to Violet "Ellen" (Logan) Carrick. George graduated from Brimley High School in 1963 and still holds the conference long jump record; attended Michigan Technological College Sault Branch on a basketball scholarship and enlisted in the United States Air Force January 1966 through May 1969 serving in Vietnam in DaNang. He went on to work for Algoma Tube in Dafter, MI in 1972 and worked there for 17 years. He went on to work for the Department of Corrections as a Corrections Officer in 1987 until he retired in 2004. George enjoyed tinkering in the garage, restoring tractors, playing softball, snowmobiling, camping and vacationing with family and friends; but he most cherished the many tractor pulls he participated in with all his Grandchildren.
