Georgina Mary Miller, age 94, of Barbeau, Michigan passed away early Monday morning, January 13, 2014 at Cedar Ridge Assisted Living in St. Ignace, MI with her husband of 73 years by her side. Georgina was born on Neebish Island, on May 5, 1919 to the late James and Ethel (Cruickshank) Lawrence. She graduated from Sault High School. On July 3, 1942, she married Robert E. Miller at the First United Presbyterian Church Manse. Georgina and Robert were small business owners in the Soo, owning the Bilt-Mor Motel for a number of years. In later years, she enjoyed going to the casino and visiting with people she would meet. She was a member of the St. Mary's River Sportsmen's Club and spent a number of years assisting with food drives. Georgina is survived by her loving husband Robert E.
