Harley R. Feole, Sr. age 82, of Kinross passed away early Thursday morning, November 24, 2005 at Tendercare Nursing Home. Harley was born on June 4, 1923 in Novi, Mich. the son of the late Walter and Lila (Rolfe) Feole. He served his country in the U.S. Army-AirForce during WWII, as a Sgt., working in the motor pool and heavy equipment area.
