Harold "Dick" Richard Crisp Sr., age 89, of Goetzville, Michigan, died at the Evergreen Living Center in St. Ignace, Michigan, on December 26, 2023. He was born on March 1, 1934, in DeTour, Michigan, to James Louis and Mildred (Izzard) Crisp.
