December 5, 1921 - May 17, 2008

Harold William Timmer age 86 of Brimley, Michigan passed away Saturday afternoon, May 17, 2008 at War Memorial Hospital. He was born on December 5, 1921 in Grand Rapids, Michigan. Harold graduated high school in Grand Rapids, MI and went on to serve his country in the Army Air Corp. He went on to work with Lear Inc. where he helped create such things as the gyro systems in the first generation guided missiles, first drones for the military, and the first land to air missiles. He later worked construction for many years, focusing on commercial concrete construction. Harold was a charter member of several new church starts in the Grandville/Jenison, MI area for the Reformed Church. He was active as a Sunday School teacher, School board member, church consistories, and 4-H leader. Harold loved to sing with the Hiawathaland Chorus, and Monday Morning Singers at Long Term Care. He enjoyed golfing, hunting, and fishing. Harold is survived by his wife: Margaret "Molly" (Shoemaker) Timmer, whom he married on August 6, 1943 at the First Reformed Church in Zeeland, MI, five children: Barbara (Gerald) Van Diepen of Sibley, IA, Richard (Julie) Timmer of Brimley, MI, Nancy (David) VanderZwaag of Holland, MI, Margaret (Michael) Weber of Redford, MI, and David (Mary Beth) Timmer of Zeeland, MI, 16 grandchildren, and 17 great grandchildren.
