Harry Edward Pearson, age 86, of Southfield, Michigan, died Sunday, April 26, 2015, in Royal Oak, Michigan. He was born April 10, 1929 on the family farm in Cedarville, Michigan to Joseph Axel Pearson and Hulda Wilhelmina (Mattson) Pearson.

Harry grew up in Cedarville where he graduated from High School with the Class of 1948. He was fond of high school basketball and was manager of the Varsity team. Harry was a very hard worker. In addition to working on the family farm, he also worked various jobs for neighbors. After high school, Harry moved to Detroit and began working for the Cadillac Motor Division of General Motors. He took leave from there to serve in the United States Army in 1951 and he served at Fort Worden, Washington until 1953. After his service, Harry returned to Detroit and his job at General Motors until his retirement.
