Henry Jackson Anderson, 85, Native American name "Raven" member of the Cherokee Ani-Yun-Wiya Nation born November 10, 1935 in Tifton, Georgia passed away Sunday September 12, 2021 in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan. Henry married Marlene (Payment) Anderson on July 18, 1964. Henry was a Korea and Vietnam Era Veteran who served over 20 years in the U.S. Air Force and retired January 31, 1974 from Kincheloe Air Force Base, Michigan. He owned and operated Anderson Pest Control in Kinross, Michigan serving Sault Ste. Marie and surrounding area for over 35 years.

Henry is survived by his wife of 57 years, Marlene Anderson; daughter, Maureen Anderson; brothers, Homer Lee Anderson of Ohio and Drue Felix (Joyce) Anderson, Jr. of Georgia; sister, Mary Coronado of Florida; sisters-in-law, Rosemary Lane of California and Barbara (Chuck) Harris of California; grandchildren, Andrew Jackson Anderson, Jordan Pavlat, and Eddie Gabriel; granddaughter, Ashley Ley; and great granddaughter, Lily Ley.
