Leo Krzeminski, 93 of Mackinac Island passed away early Wednesday, March 31 at the home of his daughter in Canton, MI. He was born March 30., 1918 in Wyandotte, MI. to Anthony and Mary Krzeminski. He was a Tool & Die maker in Detroit for 28 years for Star Tool & Die. He also was a butcher at Doud's Market on Mackinac Island. He was a member of Ste. Anne's Catholic Church on Mackinac Island; the American Legion on Mackinac; and the VFW; after serving his country during WWII. He also was a member of the Knights of Columbus. He loved his family, and was always a very gracious gentleman. He had lived the past 12 winters in Canton with his daughter. He married Ann Marshall in Napoleon, Ohio in 1942, and she died on Feb. 25, 1999.
