



## James "Vic" Victor Trombley

December 3, 1930 - September 25, 2010

James "Vic" Trombley, age 79, of Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan passed away Saturday morning, September 25, 2010 at his home surrounded by family. Vic was born on December 3, 1930 in Sault Ste. Marie, the son of Frank and Mae (Bush) Trombley. Being a skilled craftsman with an analytical mind, he enjoyed a diverse employment history. He moved back to the Sault area after an honorable discharge from the United States Air Force in 1954. He worked at Wieneke Sault Motors and Lietz Sports Center, owned and operated the Dog & Suds Drive-in with his wife and children, and held the position of operations manager at Sault Yard and Marine before moving to the Detroit area with Cushman Enterprises. Later he retired as a finishing specialist with Vogue Furniture before returning to the Sault in 2002. Vic enjoyed photography, building large remote control boats, and watching the large ships and other river traffic. He also enjoyed taking drives out to his favorite lighthouses. Vic is survived by his wife: Susan (Freeborn) Trombley, whom he married on June 30, 1956 in Marquette, MI; two daughters: Terri Parker and her son Matthew Parker of Sault Ste. Marie, MI and Vicki (Roger) Kaley of Traverse City, MI; and two sons: Mike Trombley of Alanson, MI and Jay (Brenda) Trombley and their children Hannah and Jacob Trombley of Westland, MI. He was preceded in death by his parents: Frank F.
