Jerome Florian "Jerry" Ignatowski, age 55, of Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan passed away unexpectedly on Wednesday, October 7, 2009 near Fibre, Michigan. Jerry was born in Saginaw, Michigan on April 17, 1954. He graduated from St. Stephen's High School with the Class of 1972 and attended Lake Superior State University.
