Rev. John Joseph Lehman, Lt. Co. Chap. USAF (retired) passed away at Our Lady of Wisdom Health Care Facility in New Orleans, Louisiana on Monday February 24, 2014 at the age of 89 years. Son of the late Ada Folland Lehman and Joseph Lehman. Brother of Marjorie (Albert) Monkman, Katherine (John) Ripley, Mary Jane (Ernest) Allen and identical twin brother James (Mary Ann Johnson) Lehman. He is survived by numerous cousins, nieces, nephews and their children and grandchildren. Rev. Lehman was born in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan and spent the last 25 years in Barataria, Louisiana. He was an avid fisherman and assisted at St. Anthony Catholic Church in Lafitte, Louisiana, near his home. He spent his summers in Sault Ste. Marie and could often be seen bouncing between the outlying parishes to lend a hand. He served in the Pacific in 1944 and after the war he entered the Sacred heart Seminary in Detroit, Michigan and was ordained for the Diocese of Marquette, Michigan in 1956. The Lehman twins were inseparable, falling out the family's second floor window together at age four, attending the same universities and enlisting in the navy on the same day. Father John lost his only sister-in-law in 1898 (she was 58 years old) and the Lehman twins spent their later years as retired educators on summer sabbaticals, seldom agreeing on anything they discussed. Subsequent to any disagreements, they seemed to make up quickly in order to move on to the next topic of discussion. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held 11:00am Friday June 27, 2014 at St. Mary's ProCathedral Church with Father Sebastian Kavumkal as
