Jon Brian Johanson, age 68, of Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan passed away Monday evening, September 26, 2011 at War Memorial Hospital. Jon was born on April 21, 1943 in Mount Pleasant, Michigan the son of the late Oscar and Mildred (Hall) Johanson. Jon served his country in the U.S. Navy on board the USS Kearsarge, an aircraft carrier based in Long Beach, California. He attended Kirtland Community College, Wayne County Sheriff Police Training Academy, and the Indian Police Academy of Utah State University. Jon served Clare County Sheriffs Department as a deputy, then developed a Tribal Police Department in Mount Pleasant area. Later he developed the Sault Tribe Police Department where he was Chief of Police. He was also a Private Detective both here and down state. Jon was a member of the American Legion Post #3, the Moose Lodge #717 , the Cherokee Nation, and Disabled American Veterans. Jon was an honest man who enjoyed traveling, smoking his cigars, hunting and fishing. Jon continued to study Sociology, Psychology, and the indigenous rights of the Native Americans. Jon is survived by his wife: Marjorie L. Hartwig, who he had been with for 26 years, a son: Brian J. (Amber) Johanson of Bedford, TX; two daughters: Amy A. Johanson of Sault Ste. Marie, MI; and Jennifer R. Johanson of Brimley, MI; a sister: Charlene Woodbury of Mount Pleasant, MI; and eight grandchildren: Kaitlyn, Casey, Michael, Shelby, and Kaleb Johanson, Joshua Messer, Haley Brown, and Zoey Parrish. Jon was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers: Arnie and Bob Johanson. A memorial service will be held at 12:00

noon on Saturday, October 1, 2011 at C.S. Mulder Funeral Home with Pastor Eloise Kremel officiating. Friends may call at the funeral home from 10:00 AM until the time of the service. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be left to help with funeral expenses.
