



## Joseph Leonard Frost

February 5, 1943 - January 28, 2024

Joseph Leonard Frost, age 80, of Sault Ste. Marie died at McLaren Hospital in Petoskey, Michigan on January 28, 2024. Joe was born in Hessel, Michigan to Clifford and Verna (Rapson) Frost on February 5, 1943.

Joe grew up in Sault Ste. Marie and graduated from the Sault High School. After graduation, he joined the Army where he was stationed in Germany. Once returning, he attended Henry Ford Community College in Dearborn, Michigan and graduated with his Associates degree. Joe went on to marry the love of his life, Joan Wurm on July 11, 1969 and worked for the Ford Motor Company until 1977 when he moved back to Sault Ste. Marie where he opened his business "J. Frost Donuts". Joe owned and operated it until 2002 before selling it. To supplement his time during his retirement, he worked at Bay Mills Casino until 2015.

Joe was an avid Detroit Sports fan and enjoyed watching all the games. He enjoyed traveling, spending time with his family, conducting debates in politics, and watching his great-grandson's hockey games.
