Judith "Judy" Ann Nixon, age 78, of Pickford, Michigan, died on February 18, 2025, at Munson Medical Center in Traverse City, Michigan. She was born on February 28, 1946, in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan, to Mervin George and Janice Vivian (Batho) Lockhart.
