Karyn Marie Mohr, age 59, of Barbeau, Michigan passed away Sunday morning, May 23, 2010 at War Memorial Hospital. She was born in Flint, Michigan on March 2, 1951 to the late Robert and Carmen (Canton) Tobias. Karyn graduated from Kearsley High School with the class of 1969, and went on to take some college courses at LSSU. Karyn was a member and a minister at Rosedale Community Church, where she taught Sunday school and was a youth leader for many years. She worked for the Soo Co-op Credit Union for 10 years, and enjoyed bowling with the Credit Union in the Ladies League. Karyn also enjoyed gardening and working in her flower beds, but most of all, she enjoyed spending time with the grandkids. Karyn is survived by her husband: Rev. Lionel "Lon" Mohr, whom she married on August 30, 1969 in Flint, MI; two sons: Michael (Belinda) Mohr of Rose City, MI, who is currently stationed in the Persian Gulf, and Heath (Melissa) Mohr of Sault Ste.
